Day 1 – Welcome to Peru

Day 3 – Private tour of Pisac´s Inca Ruins and its typical Market



We will take you to the small valley town of Pisac where you will visit the incredible Inca ruins placed on the ridge over the town. You will be able to walk down upon agricultural terraces. Then, stroll through the native village and its colorful artisan market.

Day 4 – The Lost City of the Incas: Machu Picchu

When you get to Machupicchu the incredible Inca stone construction will be spread below, alternately hidden and revealed by clouds. A truly breathtaking moment.
